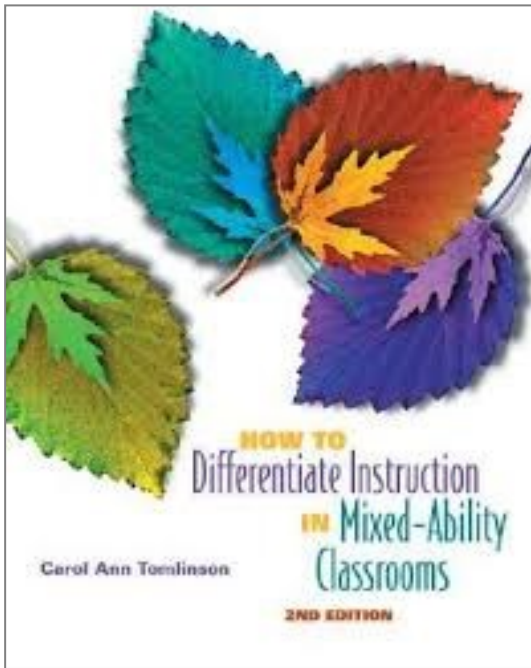


Book Review

This is a slim volume and was published a while ago but don't let this put you off – it is full of practical ideas for differentiating in mixed-ability classrooms. The book starts with a description and rationale for differentiation which these days will be very familiar to teachers.

The value in this book comes later with ways to differentiate by readiness, interest or learning profile and ways to differentiate the content of lessons, the process of learning the content and showing what learning has taken place. There are quick tips and troubleshooting advisories throughout the book.

Carol Ann Tomlinson has written other books on Differentiated Instruction that are also well worth reading.
